RACE REPORT

The Arnison Crag Horseshoe is held as part of Patterdale Dog Day and takes place in between the sheep dog trials. Fortunately, dogs and runners know their place! It is a beautiful setting amongst wonderful scenery.

Arnison Crag Horseshoe is only a 3 mile/5 km route but it punches above its weight/distance . It manages to combine grassy uphill running and muddy squelchy uphill running, with a bit of flatish track and a lovely undulating run from Trough Head to Arnison Crag. The descent from Arnison Crag is steep, grassy, slippery and stoney in places – fabulous if you love downhill running. And this year, the sun shone on the day but conditions underfoot were wet and boggy in places.

This didn't stop 4 records being set. Lou Roberts from Ambleside smashed the record for the ladies and over 40's ladies by taking nearly 3 minutes off her 2015 time. Paul Carnforth from Borrowdale set a new male over 50's record and a new local record was set by junior runner, Bertie Tweed. It was also lovely to see a lot of our "regulars" and to welcome 4 runners who had never run a fell race before. They were still smiling by the time they reached the finish line.

47 runners were set off by Mike Beaty, who has just retired as Chairman of Patterdale Dog Day after umpteen years in the post. He and Dave Hodgson were instrumental in re-introducing the fell race to Patterdale Dog Day after a gap of many years.

First runner back was Martin Mikkelsen-Barron from Borrowdale in a time of 23.27, followed by fellow Borrowdale runner, Ted Ferguson, in 24.04. Third home was the Show President, Charles Lowther from Eden Runners, in 24.46. Matt Reedy from Ambleside AC finished 4th in a time of 25.39 to claim the first male over 40 prize and Paul Cornforth from Borrowdale was first male over 50 in 6th place in a new record time of 26.35. First over 60 was Jonathan Haynes from Bishop Stortford in 32.18.

Lou Roberts from Ambleside AC stormed round the course to finish 9th overall and set a new ladies record of 27.03. This is also the ladies over 40's record. Lou was 2 minutes and 50 seconds faster than in 2015! Second lady was also from Ambleside – Hazel Robinson in 30.22 and third lady was Jo Buckley from Calder Valley in 32.50.

We also had three junior runners which is always good to see – and all were locals! First junior back was Bertie Tweed in a new local's record of 28.01, followed by his brother, Archies Tweed in 32.16 and Isaac Ravenhill in 33.00. Bertie Tweed improved on his 2016 time by 6 minutes and 23 seconds so watch out in 2018!

Finally a BIG thank you to Catstycam Outdoor Shop in Glenridding for sponsoring the prizes: ; to Vanessa Schaeppers, Sarah Moseley, Rachael Freedman and her young cousin, Phoebe, for helping with registration and the
